

DRIVE THRU ASSESSMENT – PATIENT GUIDANCE

You have been asked to have an assessment by a nurse to determine what care you may need for a possible Covid-19 infection.

Before you attend, your surgery needs to know if you are allergic to any antibiotics, and which pharmacy is your nominated pharmacy for electronic prescriptions.

PLEASE NOTE - YOU WILL NOT BE TESTED FOR CORONAVIRUS AT THE DRIVE THRU.

1. Someone else must drive you to the assessment.
2. Drive to Littlehampton Health Centre, BN17 5HG. The entrance is for cars is in Church Street, just after the roundabout - do not drive in early – wait for your appointment time.
3. The Car park Marshall will direct you on arrival.
4. DO NOT OPEN YOUR CAR DOOR OR LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE.
5. ONLY OPEN THE WINDOW WHEN INSTRUCTED TO DO SO.
6. DO NOT SPEAK TO THE NURSE UNLESS ASKED TO DO SO.
7. You will be directed to a nurse who will apply alcohol gel to your hands.
8. When the gel has dried, extend the arm nearest the window as far out from the car as possible.
9. The nurse will put a sensor on your finger which measures oxygen in your blood and your pulse.
10. The nurse will tell you what to do next as a result of the assessment.
